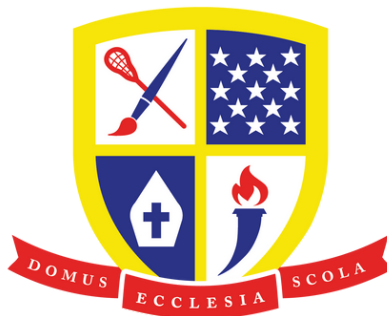

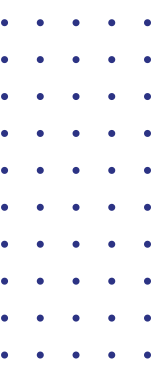

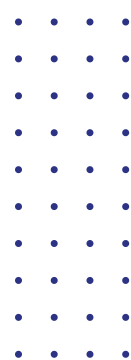
# Morning & After Care

Awardees' families are notified through FACTS and scholarship distributions are made directly to the school on behalf of the successful scholarship applicant.

Greenwich Catholic School also offers tuition assistance to eligible families. Families who wish to apply for financial aid must first apply to the Bishop's Scholarship Fund through FACTS online. The financial aid applications in FACTS are evaluated and awards are determined by the GCS Tuition Assistance Committee. Families are directly notified by the Committee.
